Martin Taylor graduated from Plymouth University in 1998. Prior to this, he was an Associate Director at Roberts Limbrick Architects, a nationally significant sports and leisure practice in Gloucester, UK.

Martin has extensive experience project managing building types as well as master planning and urban design. This experience covers commercial and retail, transport and mixed use, residential and industrial, cultural, health, education, as well as sports, leisure and entertainment facilities. He has international experience in the planning, running, design and delivery of sports projects and master plans. His key recent skill areas are sports venue design experience, legacy and regeneration aspects associated with sports sites, as well as the adaptation and integration of heritage and restoration of historic fabric.
